Garden Overview

It is a joy to see the changing seasonal beauty in the Perennial Plant Garden. When you visit you can enjoy the beautiful butterfly bushes, striking orange poppies, balloon flower and Joe Pye Weed. A particular favorite of this garden is the famous gas plant! If you visit in the fall you'll see an array of mums, asters, and a variety of sedum all in full bloom.

The Perennial Garden at Cedar Crest was established in 1989 by the Shawnee County Extension Master Gardeners. These volunteers plan, plant and maintain this garden for the enjoyment and education of the public. The Perennial Plant Garden is located directly across SW Cedar Crest Road from the Native Plant Garden at the Fairlawn entrance to the Kansas Governor's Mansion.

Feature Plants

- **Desert Candle** (*Yucca filamentosa*) Provides winter interest in the garden.
- Joe Pye Weed (*Eupatorium purpureum*) Flowers attract butterflies, moths and native bees.
- Willow Amsonia (*Amsonia tabermaemontana*) Light blue, star-like flowers appear in late spring.


