Featuring: **Keynote Speaker Larry Schwarm**, who received his MFA from the University of Kansas. He taught at Emporia State University before joining the WSU faculty as Distinguished Professor of Photography in 2013. He is known for his fire photos, farm scenes, and unique portraiture. Come hear him talk about his photos, his subjects, and his thoughts on what makes a good photo.



Course	Description
<b>Composition</b>	Three different composition classes are offered, with different applications of photo foundations including: <b>Comp A:</b> Leading lines, foreground, and rule of thirds <b>Comp B:</b> Includes framing, mergers, and background <b>Comp C:</b> Includes shapes, textures, and colors
<b>Daily Stories in the Pictures</b>	Youth will learn to find/ tell “tell the story” behind each photo. The purpose is to get photographers (and photo viewers) to think about the story as a part of the picture and photographing process.
<b>Portraits</b>	Some props (hats for every occasion) will be provided along with lights, diffusers and color filters so youth can create some unique portraits
<b>Photo Judging</b>	This session will use the popular phone/tablet game Kahoot to competitively judge (and probably argue about) photo placements and problem classes in a fun way.
<b>Black &amp; White</b>	This presentation and set of stations will explain what subjects work well for black and white and keys to a good photo for B&W competition.
<b>Editing with Digital Light</b>	This class will differentiate between photo enhancement and photo manipulation. It will include some demonstration of the different effects and tools available under both enhancement and manipulation.
<b>Paint w/ Light</b>	Painting with Light (Low Light) – A chance to learn a few tricks with low light photography. (A tripod and camera (or phone) with a Bulb setting help.)

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Photo Judging Contest offered in three age divisions with 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> Place Prizes in each division. Judging starts at 11:30 a.m. (written test & photos).



Registration fee:

- **\$5 for workshop sessions** is per person and includes the keynote presentation and four workshop sessions. Anyone attending a workshop needs to pay the fee.
- **\$2 for photo judging** contest to cover fees
