RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Participants and/or animals must meet all 4-H or FFA requirements
2. Participants must show proof of ownership or lease papers on animals

exhibited. Copies of Dairy ID and/or lease papers need to be submitted with entry forms.

3. All breeds will show together. Classes will be determined by animal age.

4. Showmanship will be determined by exhibitor age.

5. This show is open to all countries and states.

6. Bedding not allowed inside the show barn. Must clean up all manure and hay before leaving fairgrounds.

7. Blocking chutes will be allowed around the exterior of the show barn, but not in, because of space.

8. Generators are encouraged-BUT not allowed in the show barn.

9. The show committee reserves the right to disqualify any entry deemed ineligible to show. Their decision is final.

10. The show committee is not responsible for accidents, injury, theft, loss or damage.

11. All animals must be individually identified by an official breed registration, tattoo or tag.

12. You must exhibit your own animal UNLESS you have 2 animals in the same class, in which case another bona fide exhibitor will be allowed to show.

13. Health Requirements:

A. All animals must be accompanied by a health certificate issued within 30 days of the show.

B. All animals with lesions of ringworms, warts, or infested with mange will not be permitted to exhibit.

C. IF any animal originated from a state other than Kansas exhibitors should contact the Kansas Health Department for requirements (785)-296-2326. Nebraska animals over 6 months of age need to show proof of a TB test within 60 days of show.

D. A veterinarian will be on site to look over all cattle.

- Class 13 5-year old Cow (Born September 1, 2013 - August 31, 2014)
- Class 14 Aged Cow (Born before September 1, 2013)
- Class 15 Dry Cow (Any age - must have calved at least once)
